

Table Top Booth

Table Top Booths normally have only one side exposed to an aisle and are generally arranged in a series along a straight line. They differ from Inline Booths because of their smaller size in depth.

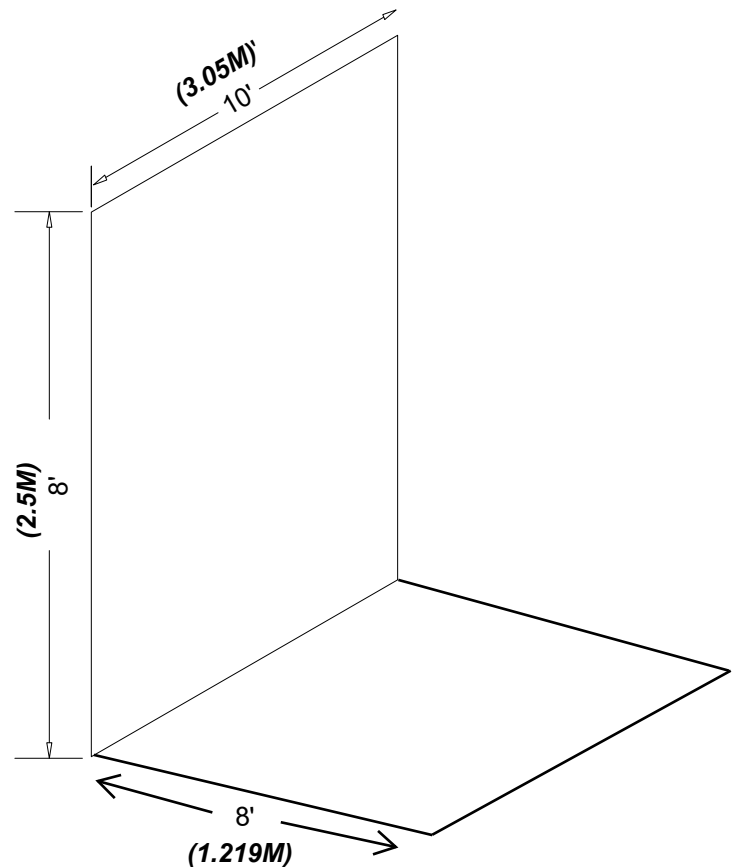
Dimensions

For purposes of consistency and ease of layout and/or reconfiguration, floor plan design in increments of 10 ft (3.05m) has become the standard in the United States. A Table top booth measures 10 ft wide by 8 ft deep. Each booth includes black booth drape, one 6 ft table, two chairs, and an identification sign.

Please note: Exhibitors may bring their own backdrop, provided it does not exceed 8 ft in height.

Use of Space

Due to the depth of Table Top Booths, it is imperative that display materials are arranged in such a manner so as not to obstruct sight lines of neighboring exhibitors. The maximum height of 4 ft (1.22m) applies to the entire booth space and displays.



**Table top booths do NOT include back or side draping.*
