

## 1. SHIPPING GOODS TO THE SHOW (Courier, Road partloads, Airfreight, Seafreight)

Before shipping any items to your stand please make sure you get in touch with the official material handling company, RESA EXPO LOGISTICS. They will be happy to solve your doubts and offer their services for reception and delivery or unloading to stand of your materials. Please note that the venue does not receive, customs clear or store any incoming shipments. If you intend to ship goods directly to your stand, you need to be there in order to sign off the delivery note of your transport company. However non-EU shipments need an importer of the record and cannot be consigned directly to the venue, as they will get stuck at customs.

Therefore, we strongly recommend to send all shipments via Resa Expo in order to ensure smooth and in time delivery to your stand. Please contact them before shipping to get individual instructions tailored to your needs.

## 2. SPANISH CUSTOMS AND HEALTH AUTHORITIES (Food and Non-Food shipments)

Any shipment coming in from outside the European Union needs to be cleared on the name of a Spanish company acting as importer of the record and paying the related import duties and taxes.

The same stands for health inspection in the case of food shipments. Resa will act as importer by providing their import registration number to customs and health authorities. Please make sure to contact them before shipping.

## 3. SEAFOOD EXCELLENCE GLOBAL AWARDS

Seafood Excellence products need to be **packed separately** from exhibition goods and need to be labelled as such. In case you send materials for Awards together with your exhibition materials, make sure the complete shipment arrives within the deadlines set up for Awards shipments (see point no. 5.2. for deadlines). Resa will provide labels and shipping instructions, so please make sure to contact them before shipping:

#### 4. PERISHABLES, TEMPERATURE CONTROL, COLD STORAGE

The organizer provides a central cold storage area for cold Seafood products, no other foodstuff accepted.

To ship your goods to the central cold storage area, please check on the following **2 options**. Also bear in mind the deadlines mentioned in point no. 5.

*ATTENTION: Temperature control courier shipments (DHL, UPS, TNT, Fedex) can become a serious problem since these companies cannot perform customs / health clearances nor are there cold storage facilities available to these companies at Barcelona airport.*

*Please check with Resa before using such a company.*

##### 1. **NON EU**

Shipments originated outside the EU need to clear customs/health and therefore need to run via RESA EXPO.

Resa can provide exact instructions regarding when and where to ship.
